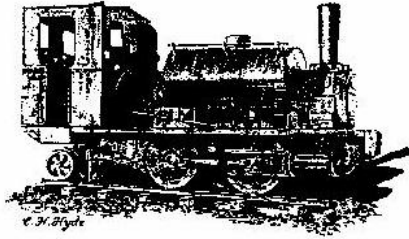

The most recently completed was the remodelling of the fleamarket building to make room for a workroom-cum-storage area in the rear. Because we want this space

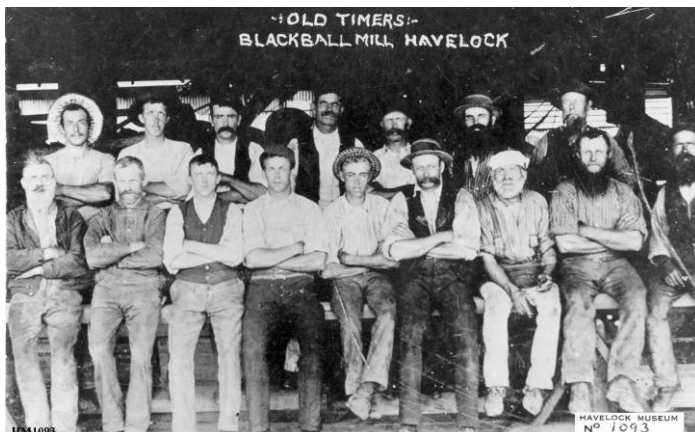
separate from the public we had to provide a new emergency exit in the form of a door half way along the side.
